The foundation was poured and included the underground plumbing works and septic tank. The teacher and local contractor were there to greet and get the team in motion.











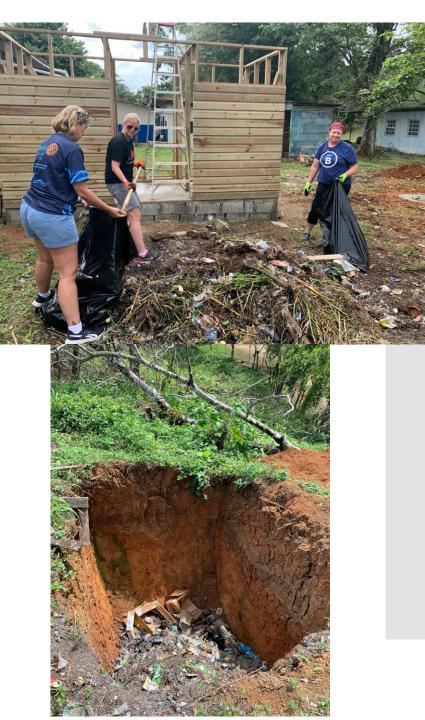


Day One wrapped up with lots of progress yet still plenty of work to do.
