Rotary members believe that we have a shared responsibility to take action on our world's most persistent issues. **Rotary has 7 areas of focus:**

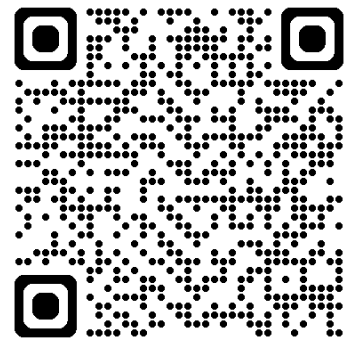
