We have just recently begun supporting the much-needed work of Family Emergency Accommodation Townsville.

Our target was to raise \$5,000 to assist the two organisations.

There were three components to the event, with the first being a six round Trivia quiz.

Second, an ongoing silent auction where people could record their bids to purchase any of the items displayed.

Third, a live auction for the three furniture items displayed on stage conducted by MC/Auctioneer Shane Smith

Whilst we are awaiting final details, we believe approximately 140 people attended the event at Cutheringa Bowls Club with an estimated profit of around \$6,500.

The evening was a great success, and huge thanks go to many people who made it happen.

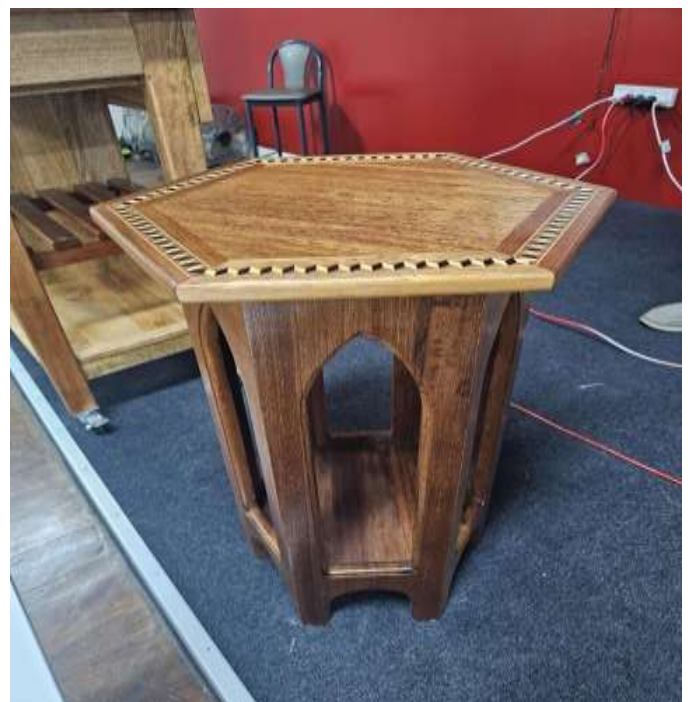
