

Rotary Charity Market

instructions for potential stall holders

The market has been operating since 1988 in Rotorua, now in Kuirau Park, raising funds for Rotorua charities. Over \$500,000 raised so far!

Proudly owned & operated by the **Rotary Club of Rotorua North.**

When?

Market is open to the public from 7:00am-1:30pm. Every **Saturday**, except Christmas Day, the market will operate. Never cancelled due to weather.

Stallholders can setup any time before 7am. New/casual stall holders should arrive after 6:30pm to find a spare site. NB. pre-booked stall holders have reserved their regular sites. By 6:30am any spare sites should normally (but not always) be available for casual stall holders. There will be 2 Rotary people on-site from 6am to 1:30pm in yellow HiViz jackets, just ask them!

Where?

Kuirau Street, Kuirau Park, Rotorua.
Next to the children's playground & toilet block.

Cost?

\$20 for a 3m x 3m site, the size of most gazebos.

\$40 for a double site = 6m x 3m.

Larger sites – ask for special pricing.

Casual: A Rotary person will come to collect the fee between 9:30am and 11:00am & will issue you with a receipt. If you have prepaid for a month, you will need to show the “prepaid site certificate” clearly on your site every week.

Prepaid/booked: If you prepay 1 month in advance, then a space can be booked for you. This payment is made on the last Saturday of each month (4 or 5 weeks paid).

What are you selling?

If you are selling **food** (anything edible) then you must have a **Rotorua Lakes Council market stall licence**; have hand washing facilities; keep food off the ground etc – basic food safety rules. Please have your food licence displayed on your stall. Food inspectors regularly come to the market to check on compliance with the rules. Questions? Other notes

Dogs are not allowed on market sites, please don't bring your dog & do dissuade the public from bringing theirs! The Rotorua District Council can impose fines for dogs in this area. There are warning signs...

Buskers are welcome & don't have to pay a stall fee, but please ask a Rotary volunteer for guidance. Maximum of 3 sites per day. Please be sensitive to stall holders who might have different musical tastes...
