

Kuirau Park Saturday Market

Information for potential stallholders 2020



The market has been operating since 1988 in Rotorua, now in Kuirau Park, raising funds for Rotorua charities. Proudly operated by the **Rotary Club of Rotorua North**.

When?

Market is open to the public from 7:00am-1:30pm. **Every Saturday** except Christmas Day and ANZAC Day. It is never cancelled due to bad weather.

The gates open at 6am.

Stallholders are to be setup before 7:30am

New/casual stallholders should arrive after 7:00am to be allocated a spare site. NB. pre-booked stallholders have reserved their regular sites. By 7:00am any spare sites should normally (but not always) be available for casual stallholders. There will be Rotary volunteers on-site from 6:00am to 1:30pm in yellow Hi-Viz jackets. Just ask them for guidance to your site!

Where?

On the site of the new carpark, corner of Pukuatua Street and Kuirau Street, Kuirau Park, Rotorua.

Cost? prices apply from 1 April 2020

Casual \$25 car boot site
 \$30 market site (3m x 3m)
 \$40 market site with power (3m x 3m)

Prepaid \$20 car boot site
paid 1 month \$25 market site (3m x 3m)
in advance \$35 market site with power (3m x 3m)

Casual: A Rotary person will come to collect the fee between 9:30am and 11:00am and will issue you with a receipt. Payable only in cash.

Prepaid/booked: If you prepay 1 month in advance, then a space can be booked for you. This payment is made on the last Saturday of each month. Please display your "prepaid site certificate" on your site every week. Payable in cash or by direct credit.

What are you selling?

If you are selling **food** (anything edible) then you must have a **Rotorua Lakes Council market stall licence**; have hand washing facilities; keep food off the ground etc. Basic food safety rules apply. Please have your food licence displayed on your stall. Food inspectors regularly come to the market to check on compliance with the rules. Questions about food selling? Other notes

Dogs: are not allowed on market sites, please don't bring your dog. The Rotorua District Council can impose fines of \$300.

Buskers: are welcome and don't have to pay a stall fee. It is essential to book. Maximum of 3 sites per day. Please be sensitive to stallholders who might have different musical tastes...
