Variety of stalls

The market has a range of stalls including fruit & veges, bric-a-brac, extensive food types, art & craft are among the stalls. And we usually have musicians or buskers adding to the atmosphere.

Types of site

There are two market areas, shown on the next page: basketball court & carpark.

The basketball court site is mostly food sites. Power is available to some of these sites.

The carpark site is all types of stalls. Power is not available in the carpark site.

Generators are not permitted (except with special prior permission).

Cars and vans are not to be parked on-site, unless you have a parking permit from the market manager. Car parking on site usually requires paying another site fee, is only available by prior agreement.

If you need more than 3m length of site, then you will need to pay for 2 (or more) sites. Gazebo and tables etc are not supplied, you will need to bring your own. Gazebos are optional.

New/casual stallholders

Please arrive at 7:00am to be allocated a spare site. NB. pre-booked stallholders have reserved their regular sites. By 7:00am any spare sites should normally (but not always) be available for casual stallholders. There will be Rotary volunteers on-site from 6:00am to 1:30pm in yellow Hi-Viz jackets. Just ask them for guidance to your site

Market opening hours 7:00am to 1:30pm

Setup: Regular stall holders are to be set up between 6am and 7am, so that unused sites can be offered to casual stall holders after 7am. Please remove your vehicle after you unload. The gates/cones will usually be closed to arriving stall holders at 8am. No further entry will be allowed for site safety reasons. **Departure:** Please don't depart before 1:00pm as we don't want vehicles moving amongst the crowd. If your site is in the basketball court area, please depart by 1:15 as the area is locked at 1:30.

The gates/cones will be closed until 1pm. You may not depart before 1pm

The market is publicly advertised as running from 7am to 1:00pm.

Rotary club volunteers are on-site from 6:00am to 1:30pm, to assist in the smooth running of the market. Stall fees will be collected between 8:30am and 11:00am by Rotary officials in yellow vests. Receipts given.

What are you selling? Food & Drink?

If you are selling **food** (anything edible) then you <u>must</u> have a **Rotorua Lakes Council market stall licence**; have hand washing facilities; keep food 500mm off the ground etc. Basic food safety rules apply. Rotary officials will check your licence <u>every week</u>. Please have your food licence displayed on your stall. Council food inspectors regularly come to the market to check on compliance with the rules. Questions about food selling? Information stalls

Political groups, religious groups, lobbyists, poll takers etc are welcome, but must not use speakers/loud hailers, and must confine their activities to their stall area – no soliciting among the crowd.

Buskers

Musicians are welcome and don't have to pay a stall fee. It is essential to book. Maximum of 3 per day. Please be sensitive to stallholders who might have different musical tastes, and be prepared to move. Power is not available, unless prearranged with the market manager.

Please don't put cardboard boxes in the public rubbish bins, you'll need to take them away with you.
