Nick Dangerfield on Reorganisation in Rotary

Nick showed video presentations about this important pilot project.

In our Rotary region (Zone 8—Australia, NZ & the Pacific) we have experienced a 23% overall reduction in membership over the last 10 years.



To address this and a number of associated governance challenges a pilot **Regionalisation Project** (see <u>Creating Tomorrow</u>) has commenced.

In September our club will vote on the proposal to proceed with developing a new streamlined regional governance approach which should reduce duplication of roles in our current District structure and provide for more efficient and effective administration.

It is envisaged that the project will evolve over a number of steps and probably over some 4 years.
