### Philippines

Hi John

The eight laptops going to the Philippines next month will be distributed by International Needs Philippines to eight area coordinators throughout the Philippines that oversee the International Needs Child Assistance Programme (child sponsorship programme) in that area. There are in total 15 area coordinators, who oversee the communication of letter writing from sponsor child to sponsor, organizing spiritual and community activities with sponsored children and their families, monitoring sponsored children well-being, and maintaining regular reporting with International Needs Philippines.

International Needs Philippines started 41 years ago with an aim to transform lives in the Philippines. Here are their main four ministry pillars:



- Education of marginalized children of mountain and rural areas through International Needs Child Assistance Programme.

- Ministry Programmes aimed at equipping local indigenous Christian leaders and Pastors to fulfil the Great Commission.

- Community Development, empowering marginalized communities.

- Health and Nutrition, addressing the fundamental needs of individuals.


**Thank you letter to Rotary for laptop**

My name is Ronji Tanielu. I serve as the Regional Director for Southeast and East Asia for International Christian Concern (ICC – [www.persecution.org](http://www.persecution.org)). I am a New Zealand citizen, but currently live in Manila, Philippines with my wife. ICC is a small ministry based in the USA that works with, serves and supports persecuted, vulnerable and marginalised Christian communities around the world. I connected with International Needs NZ (through my wife’s connections) and was informed about re-purposed laptops from your Rotary that could be gifted to overseas workers and organisations. One of these laptops was given to Ms Ana Ika from New Zealand, who then transported it to us in Asia. I then gifted this laptop to a local Indonesian missionary and community worker living in Central Java. For security purposes, I cannot disclose his name and identity. But he did not have any laptop for his community work. He was greatly appreciative of the laptop and all the efforts by Rotary, INNZ and Ms Ika to gift it to him.
