Speaker Hilary Johnson (Manager, Innovative Horticulture, Katikati College)

Hillary has visited and spoken to us before about Katikati College's Grow Hub - a course which teaches young people to grow food. Grow Hub is now in its second year and its aim is to 'spark a teen's interest in a possible career in horticulture'. On this occasion Hillary updated us on recent visits made by the students to commercial worksites, including our National Field Days

Hillary took us on a tour throughout the Grow Hub where we viewed the gardens, potting shed, glass houses, laboratory (where we saw a hydroponic system which the class developed during the late COVID years)

Hilary is now leaving the school in the hands of Kate Sutherland who has a Primary Industries background and the future for local students with an eye on the horticultural sector is looking very bright

John Buchanan entertained us firstly with some juicy anecdotes about Peter Spurdle an interesting ex RAF pilot who flew *Kittyhawks* for the USAF in the Pacific during World War II, and then later returned to New Zealand where he built the *MV WHAI*, a 48' motorized catamaran. John was involved and helped build *WHAI* which is well known for its stability and dived from it extensively for over a decade. Remarkably (and with a degree of disappointment no doubt) in 1970 John had to turn down a trip to Truk Lagoon in the Pacific the graveyard of many World War II casualties, due to his own work commitments and training back home. The *WHAI* continues to this day to be a very active charter vessel for fishers and divers and has made numerous long distance voyages into the Pacific and around New Zealand

Additional note

Tonight's meeting was held at the Grow Hub – the facility was suited to our occasion in that it was quiet, roomy and comfortable and power-point and presentation facilities are available. Cooking & cleaning facilities (including refrigeration) are adjacent and many remarked on its suitability for our purposes
