Speaker

Lori Luke, CEO of the <u>Acorn Foundation</u> last spoke to the Club in 2018, just after she was appointed to her position. Since then the size of the business has almost doubled. Some highlights:

- For nearly 20 years Acorn, the first and largest of the 17 community foundations in NZ, has been encouraging local residents to set up bequests to be professionally invested in perpetuity to provide long term funding to local causes of their own choosing.
- Acorn now has over \$55m in funds under management and distributes more than \$2 million each year in grants, scholarships and awards.
- Around \$4,000 is distributed every year for each \$100,000 that is invested in a particular endowment fund.
- Some donors do not wish to select specific charities but are happy to leave the decision to the
 Acorn Distributions Committee. Grants are selected from the many applications and carefully evaluated to provide maximum benefit to the community.
- There is no fixed charge to set up an endowment fund with Acorn. Acorn receives just 1% of the value of the fund annually for its operating costs.

Solution: Initially funding will be required.

Long term impact: To save & preserve lives, ease suffering & promote self-sufficiency in the long term.
