

## COUNTRY GARDENS

### 1 **BOGGY CREEK – LYNDON HALE AND AMANDA SAMPSON** 281 Break O'Day Road, Glenburn 3717

A garden once designed by Robert Boyle, Boggy Creek is built on the site of a fish farm and the ponds have been opened up to create two large dams. The property was severely affected in the 2006 and 2009 fires which led to planting deciduous trees and plants to attract native birds and the building of an impressive rockery which has an amphitheatre feel about it. This outstanding garden last open in 2017 has matured beautifully and is a credit to its owners.

### 2 **THE PINES – SANDRA AND JEFF CUNNINGHAM** 5381 Melba Hwy, Yea 3717

An original pine plantation backs this property featuring established native and exotic trees. There's a formal planting of roses, camelias and spring bulbs and just follow the creek which meanders through the property to experience everything it has to offer. Beside the house, the garden opens out to an ornamental lake surrounded by willows and golden ash. The lake blooms in Spring and Summer with a mass of water lilies.

### 3 **GLENGOWRIE – IAN AND PAT SICHLAU** 17 Sichlau Road, Yea 3717

This beautiful country garden had its origins in 1924 and still remains in the family today with Ian and Pat. Matured deciduous trees and the ornamental dam, Lake Inferior, are stunning features whilst providing cooling summer shade and a restful outlook. Meandering paths wind through this pretty garden to the gazebo and around the lake wall. Roses are a feature of the garden at this time of the year.

### 1 **TEMPERANCE GARDEN – CHRIS SIERS** 15 Station Street, Yea 3717

This is the old Temperance Hall purchased 7 years ago and started with 3 trees. Chris observed the movement of the sun and shadows for six months before putting any landscaping ideas into action. The decision not to use lawn was because of the work involved in maintaining it and over the past eight years has resulted in a very low maintenance studio garden.

### 2 **MILROY – JULIE MILROY** 2 Range Road, Yea 3717

Julie has been in the gardening industry for many years and this experience is demonstrated in her recently reinvented garden. Visitors are greeted by a mass planting of her front verge garden providing colour and interest for visitors and those just passing by. On entering the front, a built up garden bed has been planted with a variety of annuals and perennials, many of which have been propagated by Julie. Moving into the back of the garden, a stunning display of clematis line the fence and provides a backdrop to a variety of plants, some of which are grown for propagating.

### 3 **GARDEN WITH A VIEW – STUART AND KHIA JARVIS** 11 Lawrence Place, Yea 3717

The Jarvis Garden is situated on a 10 acre property close to Yea and is just 5 years in the making. A series of pathways lead you around sloping terrain through a variety of developed gardens. Along the way there are a number of opportunities to sit and absorb the views of the rolling hills. Due to the harsh southerly winds that occur frequently two larger gardens have been planted predominantly with native varieties of grasses, ground covers and lower growing shrubs. Other smaller gardens have a blend of plants from around the world. A planted avenue of deciduous trees on the lower level takes you to the gardens closer to the dam. Stuart's design experience is evident throughout this beautifully designed garden.

### 4 **YEA DISTRICT & MEMORIAL HOSPITAL** 45 Station Street, Yea 3717

Open to visitors for a gold coin donation. See these beautiful garden areas designed for patients to enjoy. They feature roses and native plants and even some raised vegetable gardens so the patients can get their hands dirty!

### 5 **YEA GARDEN CLUB – PLANT SALE** 2 North Street, Yea 3717

Always worth a visit. You'll find lots of the plants you've seen in the gardens as you've been wandering and inspiration from this location itself – the garden created by David Ralph and Rosemary Simon.




