Expressions of Interest are invited from people who are interested in studying Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing) in TAFE NSW – Illawarra Institute. On completion of the course, which includes work placement at Marco Polo Aged Care Services, there will be an opportunity to apply for permanent employment at Marco Polo.

About the Scholarship

Two scholarships will be offered for Semester 1, 2022.

Each scholarship is worth \$2000 which can be used for a variety of purposes such as TAFE course fees and expenses, purchase of clothing for work placement, equipment, childcare or transport).

The focus of the scholarship is to provide financial help as well as mentoring and tutorial advice.

About the TAFE course

Commencement date: 8 February 2022.

Course duration: 21 weeks. Course is on Campus at Shellharbour TAFE, full time.

The course is face-to-face and also involves some online work.

There is a clinical/work placement of 120 hours. This will mean an early start of 6.30am and a 3.30pm finish for 3 weeks full-time at Marco Polo Aged Care in Unanderra or Woonona.

Students require English Level 3 on the International Second Language Proficiency Rating (ILSPR) scale (or equivalent).

Clinical placement (work placement)

This will be provided by Marco Polo Aged Care Services Ltd. During the work placement period, Marco Polo will provide mentoring and advice.

Who is supporting the Scholarship

The Scholarship Project will involve the Rotary Club of Dapto in partnership with Marco Polo Aged Care Services Ltd, who will both provide financial support.

Clinical placement and workplace support will be provided by Marco Polo.

The Rotary Club of Dapto will provide mentoring as participants work through the course.

Process

Applicants are invited to submit an Expression of Interest (EOI) on the form which is attached.

A selection process will be held. The successful applicants will be notified and will be required to show their proof of vaccination for Covid 19. The successful applicant will enrol in Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing) in TAFE NSW – Illawarra Institute (Shellharbour) to begin study in February 2022.
