International Project Update

I have been in contact with John Bosco Agaba the Co-Founder of Divine Mercy Schools in Kanungu Uganda and have given an update from the clubs last meeting.



The decision was to support the most urgent Priority, Priority 1. To provide Water Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) and latrines for the staff and children.

John has expressed his gratitude on behalf of the children and explained what a positive effect this project will have on the children's education and health.

The water source currently is a distance from the school and is not always clean. Children miss school because of the distance they need to walk for water and also are susceptible to water borne diseases.

There is adequate rainfall during the two wet seasons that can be stored.

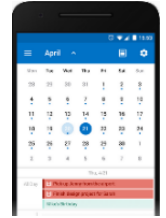

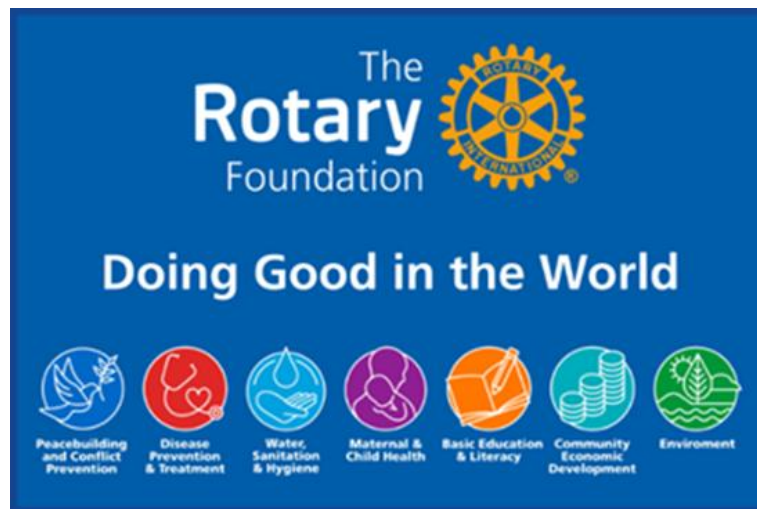
