

A little background on this evening's guest speaker: Dr Kevin Wanambiro

Kevin was born and raised in Western Kenya, where he completed his secondary education. His long-time passion for healthcare led him to the University of Nairobi, where he studied medicine and subsequently graduated in 2006.

Following graduation, Kevin began his medical career as an intern in Lodwar, north western Kenya, gaining valuable experience in community health. He later specialised in radiology, completing postgraduate studies in Nairobi and qualifying as a specialist in 2013. This was followed by a year of advanced training in Rotterdam, the Netherlands, which further enhanced Kevin's expertise in radiology.



This evening, Kevin will undoubtedly expand on his career and educational pursuits as well as a little about his family and his personal interests.

- ♣ Sergeant Di North then noted that Paws4aCause had to be cancelled last Sunday and thanked the committee of Dennis Simpson, Marilyn Phillips and Anne & Jim Christensen for their work on the project. Anne Christensen countered with a special vote of thanks for the tremendous effort Di North devoted to the project!
- ♣ The wine raffle was won by Dennis Simson (3 weeks in a row) and our newest member, Kevin Wanambiro.
