

- **President Rose** made the following announcements:
 - ❖ A reminder was issued to check the recently emailed *updated member contact list* and if any errors are identified, please let Rose know.

- Mention was made of Duncan Rutherford's membership application for transfer to our Club from the Rotary Club of Kembla.
- ❖ Club membership fees are now due; however, the Board has reduced members' fees for the 2024-2025 Rotary year to \$200pa.
- ❖ It is unfortunate that **Angela Capri** has *resigned* after many years supporting our Club and our community in many facets of Rotary. Angela is very busy with work commitments as well as being heavily involved with constructing a new home with Sal in Bungonia in the Southern Tablelands.
- **♣ Bob Armessen** spoke of our forthcoming social evening at the German Club on Wednesday 31 July and made a final call for numbers so he could book a table. At this stage, there are 19 starters looking forward to a fun evening and a sumptuous meal!
- **▶ Dennis Simpson** said there was a meeting scheduled at the dog park to discuss whether the *Paws4aCause event* would proceed. As soon as a decision is made members will be notified. If the event is cancelled, the *minute steaks purchased for the day will be donated to the Charles Hotel Saturday afternoon BBQ as proceeds from the BBQ are directed to our Club.*

 - Our guest speaker was Michael Naughtin, a now semi-retired but active lawyer working in the legal sphere of estate planning. Although the title of Michael's presentation was "Deceased Estates- War Stories", his intent was to keep the session light, but factual, informative and interesting (for a lawyer talk).

Apart from describing several court judgements, Michael outlined other issues such as the criteria for challenges to wills; how superannuation assets are treated in deceased estates; the need for testators to talk to their nominated beneficiaries; the impact of dying intestate; and the benefits and uses of testamentary trust wills.

Based on the number and range of questions from those present, it would be fair to say Michael achieved his objective. Prior to concluding his presentation, Michael created a few laughs by telling a self-deprecating lawyer joke.

Our guest was introduced and subsequently thanked by **Michael Crowley**.
