A little information about tonight's guest speaker - Stuart Barnes

Stuart was the General Manager of the WIN Sports & Entertainment Centres (WIN Stadium and WIN Entertainment Centre), in Wollongong, from December 1997 until September 2016, after working for 15 years with Sydney City Council – in the three last years, as Manager Sydney Town Hall.

Previous professions have included Teacher, Disc Jockey, and an Entertainment Officer on P&O Cruises.

As well as holding a Teacher's Diploma from the University of London, Stuart was awarded a Graduate Diploma in Public Administration by the University of Sydney, in 2015 and is one of only 14 venue managers in Australia, to hold the highest international qualification in the venue management industry – Certified Facilities Executive.

Stuart has been a Board Member and office bearer of St Mary Star of the Sea College, Wollongong City Employment and Training, Illawarra Business Chamber and Tourism Wollongong. He was the previous Chair of the Wollongong Relay for Life Organising Committee and was a member of the Wollongong City Council's Australia Day Committee.

Stuart is now semi-retired but is still involved in the event and venues industry through being a Consultant in these fields. This includes being the Project Manager for Destination Wollongong and Strategic Advisor for Inside Industry – who organise tours of the Steel Works and Port Kembla. He is an ongoing Event Manager and venue management consultant and very proud to call Wollongong home.

- → Jim Christensen, as one member of the 2024 Paws4aCause committee, asked members whether we should proceed with the event in 2025. The response was very positive and discussion ensued about possible venues/dates. Jim stated that stall holders will be approached later in 2024 to ascertain their receptiveness to supporting Paws4aCause in 2025.
- Helen Hasan participated in a recent Zoom meeting involving a number of Illawarra Rotary clubs and the following matters were discussed:
 - o The 'First 2,000 days' group (i.e. birth to school age children);
 - o 'Love Bites' program (i.e. helping teenage kids sort their issues); and
 - The 'Run Against Domestic Violence' campaign (The group is looking for someone to champion this event that is planned to occur between 30 August and 17 September next. If any member is interested in organising this event, please contact Helen Hasan direct!)

Without providing any commitment at this stage, **Rose** commented that she would *discuss the above projects at next week's Board meeting* in the context of the impact on our members in relation to our Club's current projects/programs and other combined local Rotary clubs' activities that our members are currently involved with.

- ♣ Michael Crowley announced that Nicholas Fantham has been selected as the successful recipient of the UOW Rotary Club of West Wollongong John Chaplin Memorial Scholarship over the 2024/2025 calendar years. Nicholas is an exceptional candidate with a very strong academic record and strong ties to the community through his volunteering work. Arrangements will be made for members to hear from and meet Nicholas (along with our other sponsored scholars) at a Club meeting possibly in October next.
- **♣ Bob Armessen** mentioned the *working bee at Rotary Park* scheduled for <u>9am Sunday 11 August</u>. Any additional members/friends who can make it need only each bring a pair of gloves.
- **President Rose** made the following announcements:
 - Friend of the Club, Tom O'Toole, told Rose that he is quite willing to help when he can at working bees and BBQs; however, he is not receiving any information/notification including the Club's Bulletin. - Wine raffle winners this week were Patrick Roberts and Jim Christensen... Congratulations to you both!


