Last week's meeting minutes: Scribe – Bob Armessen

- ♣ Sergeant Ken Potter ensured we started right on-time and handed to PP Phil Peckman who passed on President Rose's apology for her absence, then welcomed those in attendance.
- **Bob Armessen** gave his *reflection* on the fact that Australia is fortunate in that we have a political situation that's not the cause of rioting like so many other countries.
- ♣ Mal Bracken proposed an international toast to the city of Butler, Pennsylvania, where recent events (i.e. the attempted assassination of former US President Donald Trump) add weight to Bob's Reflection.
- ♣ Note was made that there is a possibility of a work morning at Rotary Park on Sunday 11 August More info closer to the day.

- Milan Stanojevic confirmed that we have the Kembla Grange BBQ each 4th Monday, with a weekend BBQ scheduled in September and November.
- **◆ Di North** advised that although the recent "Paws4aCause" event was a wash-out, we still profited by almost \$400, plus the result of the coffee voucher auction.
- Phil Peckman made the following comments:

- **★ Ken Potter** reminded that *RYDA* (*Rotary Youth Driver Awareness*) is next on Monday <u>9 September</u> and that a decision in respect to the *John Chaplin Memorial Scholarship recipient* will be published shortly.
- **Treasurer Noel Watt** has done the maths and confirmed that last Thursday's *Charles Hotel Joker Draw* raffle continues to attract reasonable funds from the patrons.
- ♣ Sergeant Ken then introduced Rotarian Dr Kevin Wanambiro (pictured right) who gave an interesting account of his early days in Kenya, and a time-line of his education and ultimate settling in Illawarra.

Some highlights were ...

- 1991: Three years in boarding school with his main memory being the poor food.
- 2001: Moved to the big city for Medical School. No \$\$\$ but had a great time.
- 2007: Long hours doing his internship, but now has a few more \$\$\$.
- There was a national election the same year that resulted in severe violence with some 1500 deaths.
- 2009: Began post-graduate training (radiology), fatherhood, and another failed national election.
- 2014: Earned a scholarship to go to Rotterdam in the Netherlands for more study.
- 2016: Back to Kenya before deciding to emigrate.
- 2018: Arrived in Albury NSW. Decided on Oz as he wouldn't need to learn another language, or how to drive on a different side of the road.
- 2021: Moved to Wollongong & obtained a position to practice his hard-earned qualifications.
