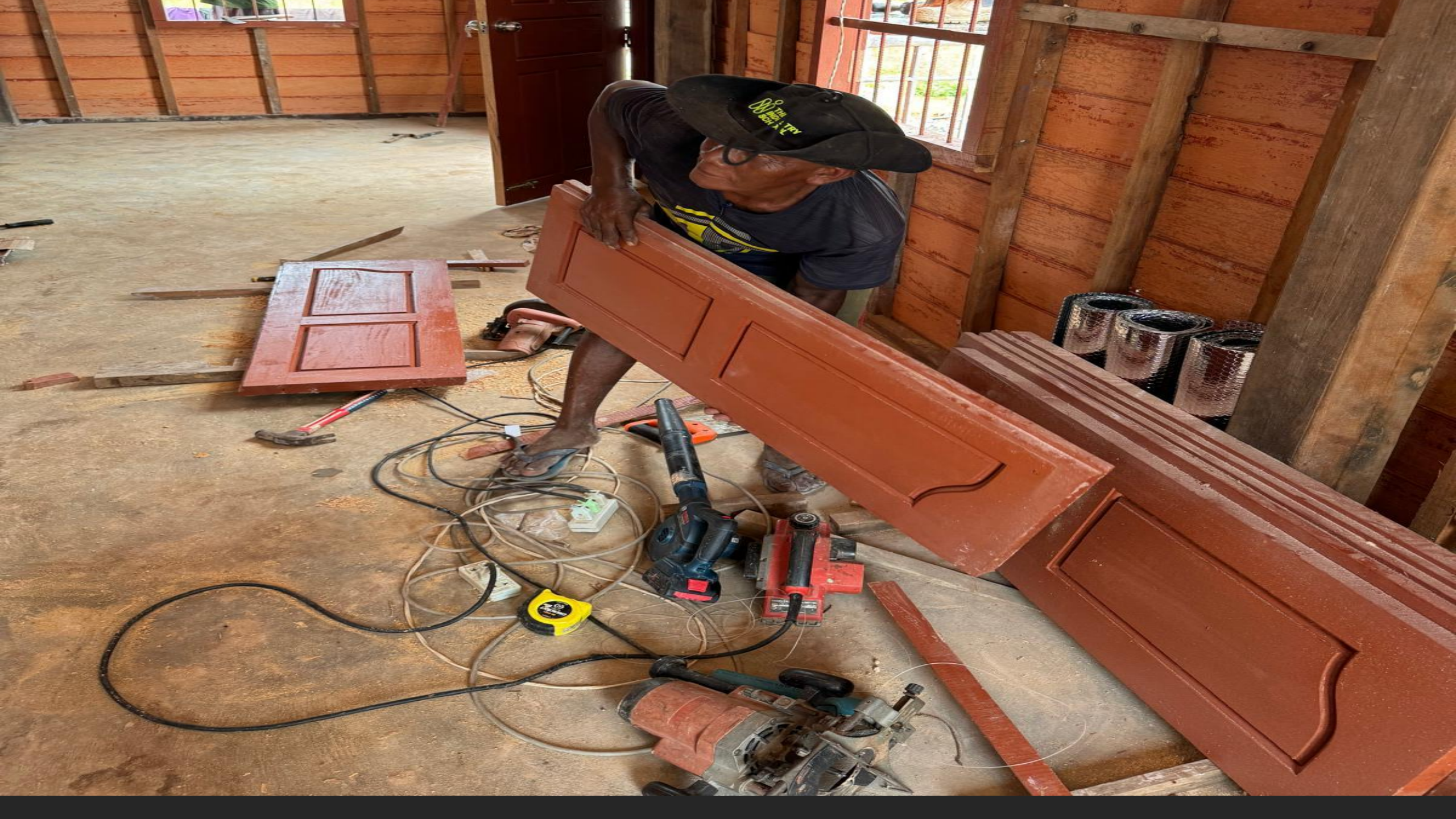




















After the building work is finished, we will have time to relax, experience some Cambodian culture and meet the people.

Or Bayon Temple with its faces

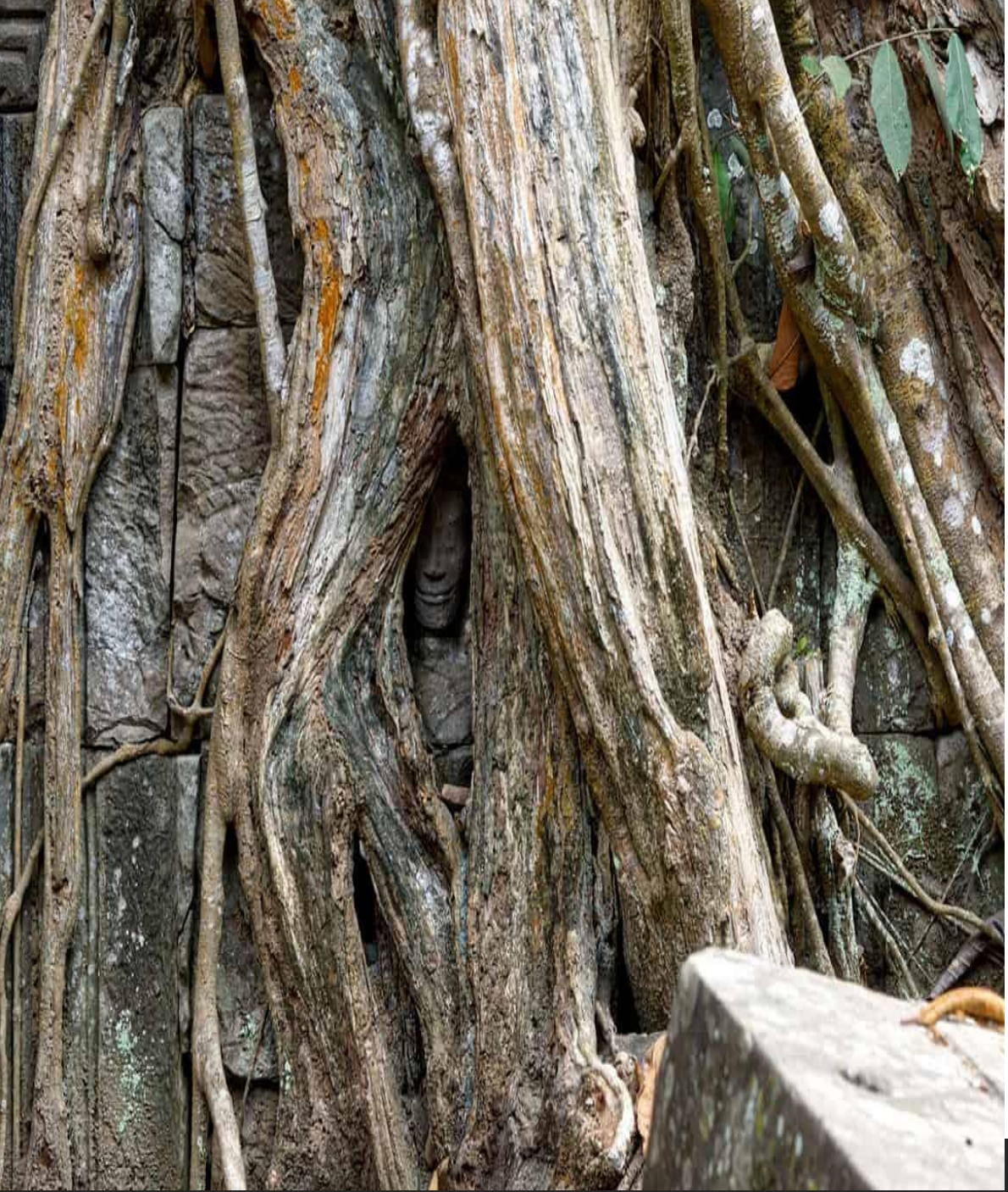






Or even Ta Prohm (Tomb Raider)

Aust \$16,000 (Fundraised)

**Total cost for the building, including pre-build work
before we arrive.**

All building Materials, Tools, Paint and equipment.

A Well, Water Tank and Pump.

Local builders to guide us and do the heavy work.

**Official Handover ceremony with photo & video record
of the build.**

Approximate travel cost for flights and tours

**Return economy airfares with Singapore Airlines
or Cathay Pacific.**

Approximately Aust \$1,400 (Singapore) return

Business Class \$4,500 (Cathay Pacific) return

**Twin share accommodation at Royal Crown
4 Star Hotel, including a buffet breakfast.**
