It was an exciting event with Father Christmas arriving for our own Christmas Pageant. The weather was warm and mild, and our takings were significant. 2 members also found time to help the Rotary Club of Tailem Bend at the Roll Racing event at the Bend Motorsport Park. Their job was to scan & their check attendee's tickets as their vehicles approached the area.

At last Wednesday's meeting our guest speakers were Tim Law and Kai Martin from the Murraylands Domestic Violence Awareness group. I hope as many of you as possible will attend the program which will run from 11.00 am to 1.00 pm (with a free bbq cooked by us to follow). I feel sure the program will be both confronting and moving particularly as you will hear from a survivor. On Saturday 25 November Rotary's statewide campaign begins with the Walk For Respect from Victoria Square to the Women's Pioneer Memorial Garden gathering at 9.30 am. It would be wonderful if some of you could join Paul and me.

The highlight of this week at our meeting on Wednesday 22 November will be the induction of 2 new members, Seun and Mobolaji. I am very excited about welcoming them as members of the Rotary Club of Mobilong. And after dinner, I am delighted to say that they (as members) will be giving a talk entitled "Our Journey from Nigeria to Murray Bridge" So do please come, members and guests, and make them welcome.














Today (Nov 19th) is International Men's Day, a day that celebrates worldwide the positive value men bring to the world, their families and communities.

ROTARY CLUB OF MOBILONG INTERNATIONAL PROJECT

Can you help restore sight to people in our neighbouring Pacific nations?

Vision of Islands is a non-profit volunteer eye surgical and clinical team, providing free-of-charge cataract removal for South Pacific Islanders (of all ages) who would otherwise be blind. To date the team, led by ophthalmologist Dr John Willoughby OAM, has worked in Tonga and Tuvalu.

The Rotary Club of Mobilong seeks financial support from clubs in District 9510 to allow Dr Willoughby and his team to continue and extend this work.

Vision of Islands operates under the direction of the Ministry of Health of each participating country. Their medical outreach team trains the local medical staff in patient care. They provide medical and teaching equipment and train local staff in their use, as well as extend specialist eye services to remote areas where people lack specialist services because of remoteness.

The team provides all the equipment, expendables and teaching materials (with backup). They remove all their refuse, leaving the island as clean or cleaner than on arrival

Their goal is to include Registrar trainees from Australasia in the program to expose them to aspects of humanitarian care where they will also see extreme need and advanced pathology. They also aim to take other professionals who may wish to serve or study topics covering several island nations.

Their first volunteer trip back to the Pacific Islands since the Covid-19 Pandemic is now underway. On this trip Dr Willoughby and his team will treat hundreds of patients in the island nation of Tuvalu.

Dr Willoughby provides his surgical skills free of charge. But there are other huge ongoing overheads like travel costs, medical equipment, transport and mobile facilities to reach remote clinics.




