On Wednesday we welcomed our District Governor (DG) Craig Dowling who spoke to us on important Club matters. At the interactive meeting with the Board, he gave us hints and advice, but cautioning us about trying to do too much. He emphasised how when we support a cause, we must ask for Rotary recognition as too often our good work goes unnoticed.

His particular focus (& therefore ours), is Saying No to Domestic Violence, of which he talked at length telling Club members how the Rotary Club of Ballina have hugely raised awareness in their area, and as a by-product, such has been community interest and support, increased their membership from around 30 to 80. He advised we should ask if we can place stickers (say No to DV) in the windows of our businesses and service areas. He mentioned the march and rally which is being held on Saturday 25 November in the CBD & in which we can participate.

He also introduced Kiki Dowling's Partner's Project - Aboriginal Chronic Disease Prevention Project, which is asking for monetary support, each year for 4 years.

Congratulations to Andrew Heard, who has been competing in the International Police & Fire Games in Canada and is bringing back 4 medals (2 gold & 2 silver).

As mentioned at our meeting, we will be having an unveiling of the donut caravan on Sunday 27 August at the Pergallinis' home and tea & coffee will be provided.

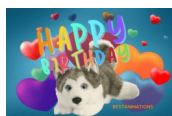

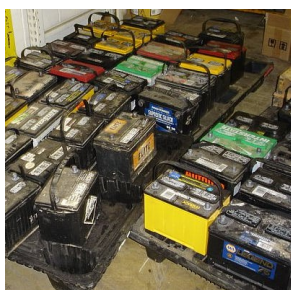

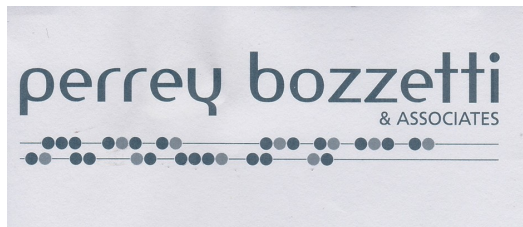
