David had important tips for us to follow to avoid being caught out, such as safeguarding our identity, not engaging in any unsolicited phone calls or emails, checking websites (as they can be fake) and requests from the ATO & the banks and the like, which can also be fake. If you suspect you are a victim of on-line fraud, report it immediately on <u>www.cyber.gov.au/report</u> or contact your local police station or visit www.police.sa.gov.au

## WELL DONE HEARD FAMILY



## CONGRATULATIONS ANDREW HEARD Submitted by Bronwyn

Andrew has recently travelled to Winnipeg Canada to compete at the World Police and Fire games. This is the 5th games Andrew has attended where Police and Fire service personnel from around the world come together to compete against each other in over 70 different sports. There were around 8,000 people who attended the games this time which is held every 2 years.

Andrew decided to nominate himself to compete in the Masters category which is the second highest category with only the High Master to go.

The competition was held over 3 days with one practice day to familiarise himself with the range then, on the first day of competition he had to shoot 60 shots over 300 metres and then on the second day he had to shoot 15 shots at 400 metres, 500 metres and then 600 metres. Andrew received Gold medals for both events. On day 1 he received the second highest score on the day seeing him out score 3 of the High Masters shooters. Andrew also joined 3 American shooters to be part of a team and with their combined scores seeing them take out the Silver medal.

The shooting is judged on ability and there are no age or gender categories whereas many sports have different categories depending on your age.

There is a 90+ year old retired Police officer from the UK who competes in the swimming and sweeps the pool winning all his events in his age group.

Another SA fire-fighter who competed was former Olympic swimmer Phil Rogers who won 7 Gold medals in his events

In 2 years time the games will be held in Birmingham Alabama and then Perth in 4 years time .
