Dear Members

Firstly on behalf of the Rotary Club of Mobilong I wish to congratulate Jill Reddin on successfully completing the Club Qualification to apply for a Global Grant.

To be eligible at least one of its members must complete and pass 9 modules.

I believe Jill achieved an outstanding result. Well done!

We are now in a position to start the process towards achieving our International project - Vision of Islands - helping to restore sight to the people of Pacific nations.

At Wednesday's meeting we heard from Lhionara (Tammy) Baker talking about her 'medical assistance dog', Dexter, who accompanied her. A medical assistance dog is one that has been trained to assist people with physical disabilities and certain medical conditions, developmental disorders, and mental health issues. They can help pull wheelchairs, fetch important items (like keys), and open draws, doors, and more. Some can also be trained to detect low blood sugar in people with diabetes, and in Tammy's case detect when an anxiety attack is about to occur. Tammy has a range of disabilities with which she needs on-going help and care. We are grateful to Tammy's informative presentation and for helping us to understand some of the challenges and obstacles faced by someone in her position, and also to understand the importance of her support her dog, a Havanese 2 year old.

This weekend (16 to 17 September) we will be full steam ahead catering at the Pedal Prix with teams helping on our BBQ trailer and our Donut caravan






