Captain Aaron Stobie has been a Salvation Army Officer for 13 years and has served with the Salvos in Victoria, Tasmania, Western Australia & South Australia. He is currently the Corps Officer & Team Leader at 'North East Salvos' which is a new initiative in the North East region of Adelaide. He is passionate about connecting with people, creating partnerships and building healthy communities.



#### **Creating Partnerships**

Aaron highlighted the advantages of a close, active relationship with the local council. He described initiatives and positive outcomes in his Club's work.

He also gave examples from his Club where partnerships with a local Church, car dealership and primary School have resulted in the formation of teams leading to benefits for all – the Club, the organisation and the community.

Aaron gave some strategies on building on current connections and developing new avenues.

This is easily checked by the labelling... Look for Return to store.
