Report of Meeting 3202 held on Tuesday 9 November 2021 at the San Giorgio Community Centre

MC Greg Rogers called the meeting to order and Chris Dawson gave the invocation and proposed the toasts.
President Keith welcomed students, teachers, families, Rotarians, partners and visitors.

A word about END POLIO - a Rotary Project.....

Rotary has been working to eradicate Polio for almost 40 years and was a founding partner of the Global Polio Eradication Initiative. Poliomyelitis is a highly infectious disease that most commonly affects children under the age of 5. Most know it as poliovirus. The virus is spread person to person, typically through contaminated water.

PDG Arthur Manser gave a brief presentation on the work Rotary has done and also gave also a personal insight to the effects of the disease. It can attack the nervous system, and in some instances, can lead to paralysis. Although there is no cure, there is a safe and effective vaccine – one which Rotary and our partners use to immunize over 2.5 billion children worldwide.

This year there are only 5 known cases, so the job is almost done!

We were also fortunate to have the Polio Relay Ute at the awards night to promote the End Polio Now campaign, and PDG Arthur Manser did a great job in selling most of our Polio Raffle books to the public as well as to some members. While the money raised through the sale of Raffle tickets goes to the End Polio Campaign it also is attributed to our club as donations to the Polio Plus Fund. We were very appreciative of Rotarian Ian Miller of Rotary Club of West Lakes for driving the Ute over and attending our Awards night. Some words below from Ian on how he enjoyed the night....

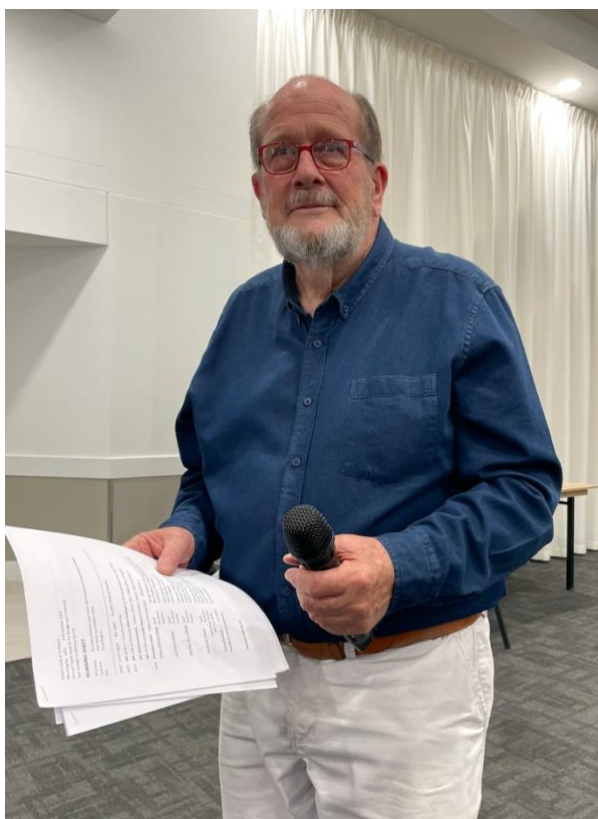
Each student received a Certificate and Cheque from the Club presented by Romaine Dawson.
