The AllKids Garden Party fundraiser was held last Sunday at St. Peters Girls School, Stonyfell Road, Stonyfell on the Chiverton Lawns & Gardens. This was an amazing setting and we were blessed with beautiful Autumn weather for the event.

In the morning, prior to the event, a group of St Peters Rotarians & members of the AllKids Cambodia Committee worked hard to set up everything. The tables were set and looked amazing particularly with the flower arrangements provided by Margaret George.



The bar was prepared with wines being supplied by Claymore Wines, Clare Valley. Workers from the school set up their PA system which proved to be excellent.

In the morning the donated food arrived & was delivered to the schools' Food Technology Centre. This proved to be an excellent facility for the food preparation. A large portion of the food was donated by St Peters Rotarians & partners. Thanks are extended to all those who prepared & donated food for the event.

At 2 pm guests were arriving & they were greeted by our guest of honour, AllKids Country Director, Paul Otto. As the guests arrived they were offered a glass of champagne which was a great way to start the event. Guests also had an opportunity to purchase wines from the wine wall. Nearly all of the 100 bottles of donated wine were sold. The gardens were buzzing with nearly 100 guests including 21 Rotarians, partners & friends.

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MC for the event was our own PDG Arthur Manser who, in his usual professional manner, welcomed guests. Arthur gave an overview of the afternoon's proceedings. Soon after this the beautifully presented finger food arrived. Tables were waited on by year 12 students from the school who had also assisted in the food preparation. They were very friendly and did a great job.



Arthur introduced Paul Otto who came back to Australia especially for this event. Paul gave a comprehensive overview of how AllKids Cambodia came into being some 12 years ago. He detailed how it has developed & expanded as well as describing some of the problems which had to be overcome particularly since the outbreak of Covid 19.

He acknowledged the work of the District Governor's wife, Jenny Neale, who established AllKids Prek Trabaek Early Learning Centre Project as her DG's Partners Project which has had a great response from Rotary Clubs. It was terrific to have Paul here for this special garden party fundraiser.

Following sweets our former St Peters Rotarian, Robin Turner, conducted an auction of a wide variety of donated goods. As well as a number of holidays there was a Chauffeur Driven Cadillac Trip to Swan Reach for which the bidding was keen.
