Guest Speaker: Erika Shaw – Norwood International High School - Pedal Prix

Erika introduced herself and explained the purpose of her visit was to showcase the Pedal Prix and seek support in sending a team of seniors to take part in the Energy Breakthrough event – Maryborough Victoria, 20-24 November 2024.

“Norwood International High School is a school dedicated to having a global outlook, committed to international mindedness in all its forms. It also provides students with numerous opportunities to expand their knowledge and dive into their passions through offering a range of sports and extracurricular activities.”

“Pedal Prix, is a popular sport amongst the students, and is available for all year levels between 7 to 12. To cater towards the large and growing community, the school runs 7 teams, with the addition of 3 community teams for adults and Norwood graduates, to participate in the community race at Victoria Park in Adelaide.”

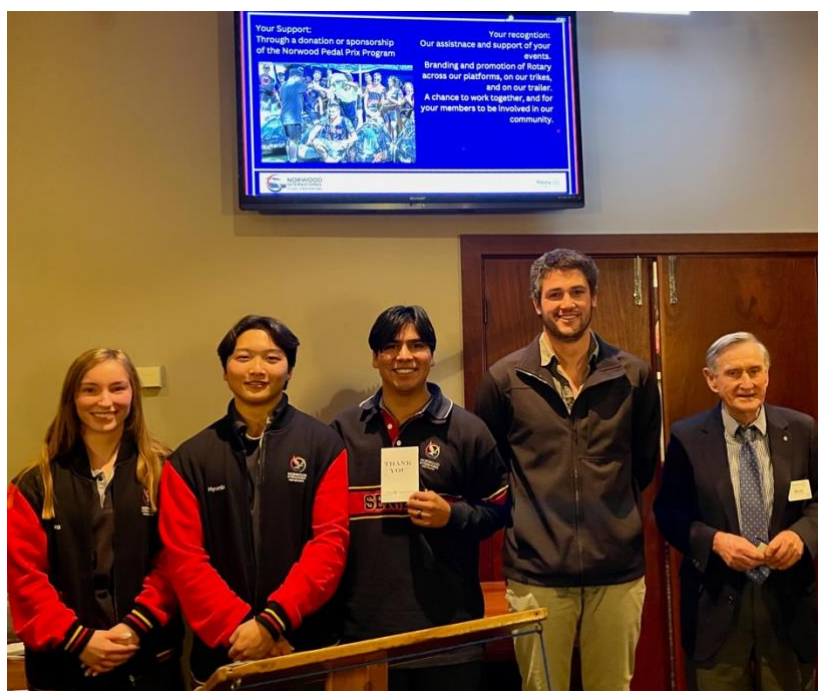
“**Ben O’Connell** is a teacher in charge of Pedal Prix and Norwood International High School, as an “extra responsibility” beyond teaching his classes as a HPE teacher. His responsibilities include the management and overall coordination and promotion of Pedal Prix. Over the past 6 years, Ben has seen the participants in the program grow, the facilities expand, and build upon a tradition that dates back to 1993 at Morialta High School.

Juan Flower, who has been a part of Pedal Prix since 2021, and **Hyunbi Moon**, who started in 2022, are year 12 students who ride for the year 12 senior boys team. Juan Flower, is a team leader, who manages and organises the team meetings that occur almost every week. Both boys make sure that they are constantly working to improve themselves, and make sure that they are attending training, building sessions, and meetings.

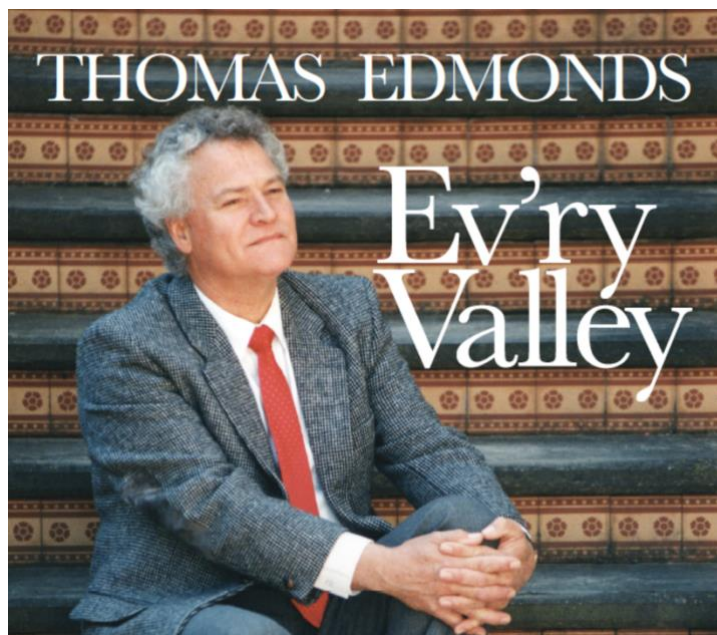
Erika Shaw, a rider since 2020, is a leader of the year 12 senior girls team, who accumulates the statistics for her team, to help track their performance and helps the team to create future goals.”

The students are asking for the Club’s help to finance the team’s cost in competing in Victoria in the Breakthrough event. In return an offer of support in Fundraising activities is proposed; as a gesture to give back to the local community.
