Fees are Payable in full by 30 September or in 2 instalments on or before 31 August and 28 February.

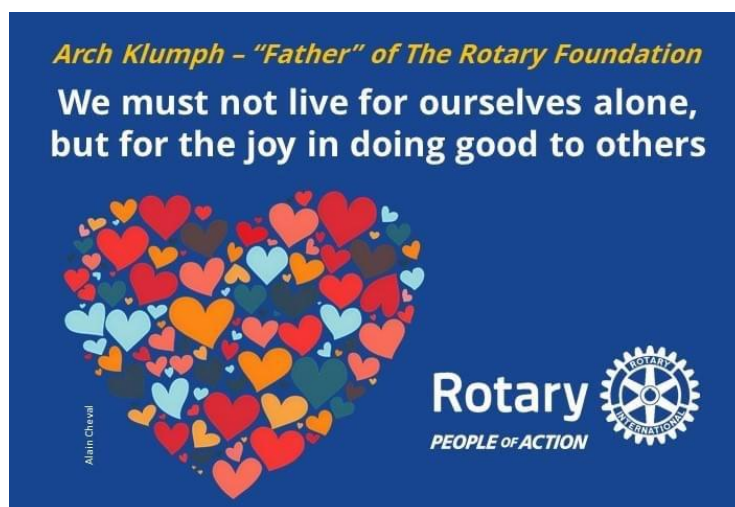

Nigel was brought up in country NSW – with a passion for mountain biking.

As a boy he found the tracks and jumps he built were often flattened by the authorities.

Nigel found through collaborating with Councils over the years as a volunteer, permanent tracks for community use could be built.

Many years later Nigel was involved in the rejuvenation of mountain bike tracks in the South Parklands in collaboration with the local council.

### Current Council Role

The local Council runs 15 volunteer programs involving 220 volunteers. These include graffiti removal, community bus, environmental projects and the Norwood pageant.

Next Monday's Council meeting will include an Information Session on Volunteering.

The Council is able to assist volunteer groups as it does with the Rotary Club of St Peters Bloke's Kitchen Project. In this case the kitchen used free of charge is a Council Asset.

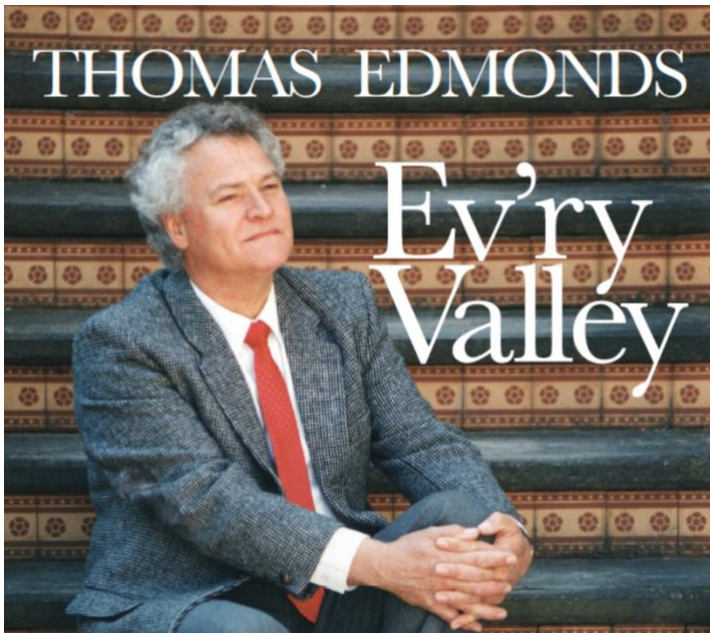
