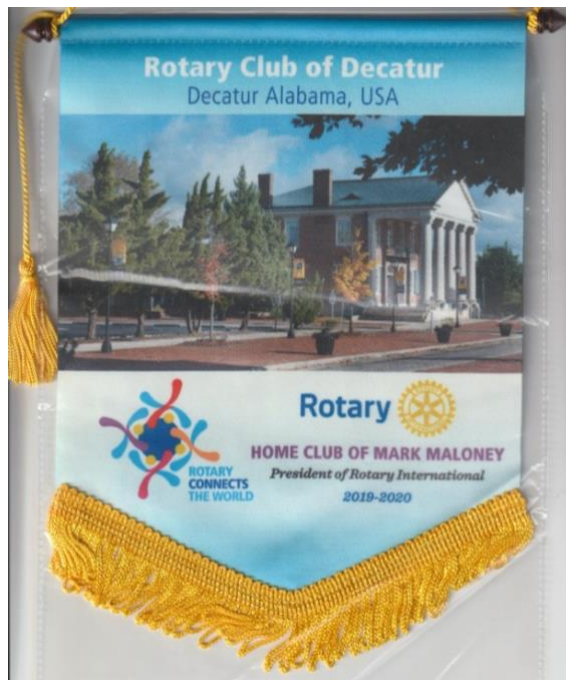
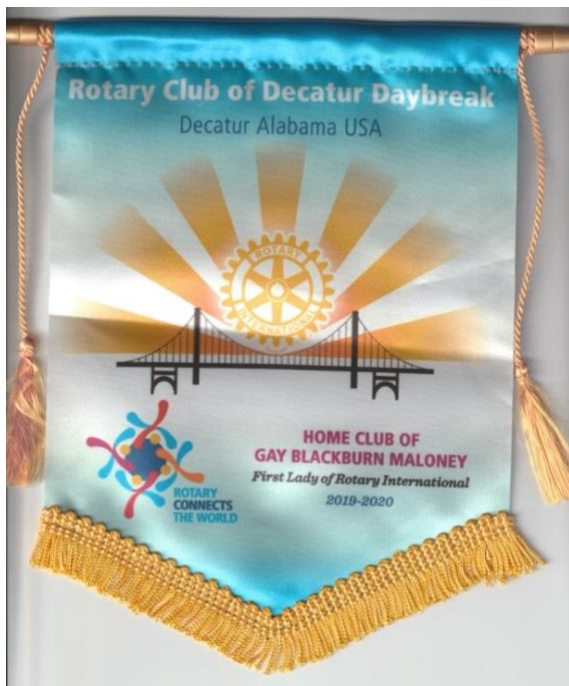

“ShelterBox exists to ensure no one is without shelter after disaster.

We often work in places that others don’t, making sure that we reach families who need support to take the next step in resuming their livelihoods.

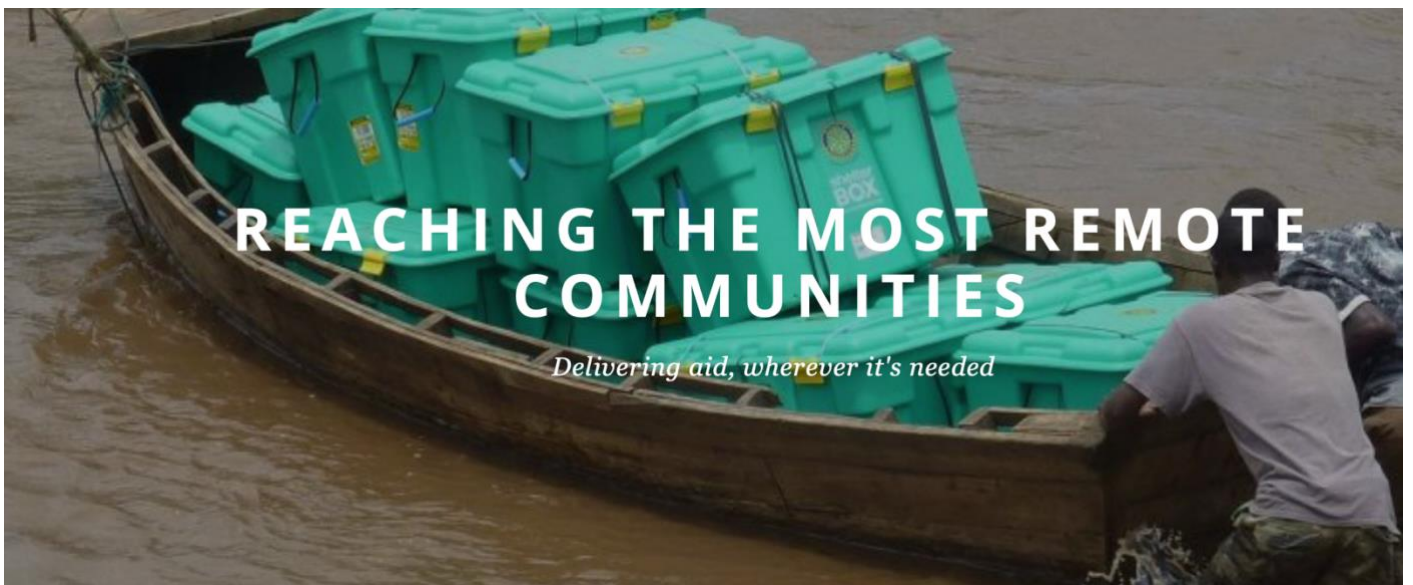
By providing emergency shelter and tools for families robbed of their homes by disaster, we’re transforming despair into hope.

From Cameroon to Syria, all the way to the Philippines and the Caribbean, ShelterBox has provided shelter to over 2.5 million people so far.

Please note that Shelterbox no longer uses unnecessary plastic packaging for environmental reasons.



ShelterBox - So what exactly is the product?

Temporary shelter for ten folk. A tent you can stand up in with three pods.

Tools for erection of the tent, a water filter, solar light with USB charger, warm blankets and kitchen utensils. The unit cost is approx. \$1,000.



We heard that the tent fabric is extremely durable. If pegged correctly its life can be extended.

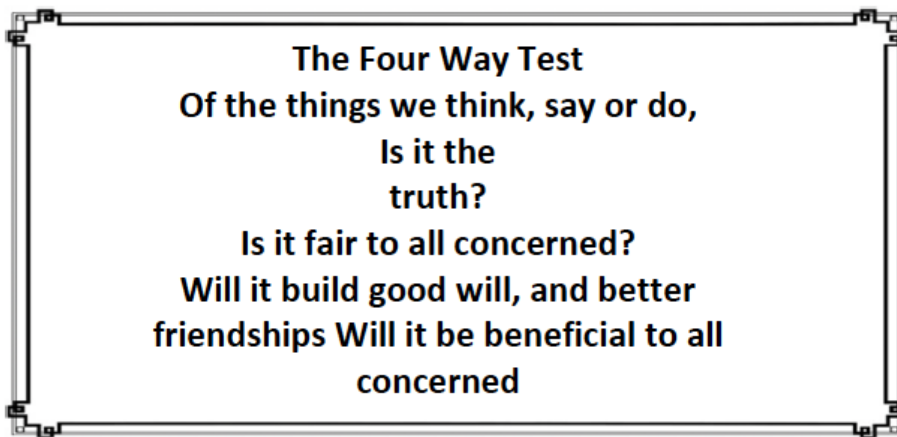
