Denese Wyatt has always believed that when faced with opportunities – grab them wholeheartedly with both hands!

Denese has enjoyed over 50 years' experience in Marketing, Advertising, Events and Public Relations for major Adelaide retail stores David Jones and Myer and running her own Marketing consultancy for major national businesses, government and the Not for Profit Sector. She also taught Art in private and public schools – all while bringing up 2 children.

Once she retired at 68, she found time for travel (funded by a directory website she set up for Adelaide hospitality venues) and writing novels. Her first novel *The Last Rose* is loosely based on true events during and after the Second World War. The next, *The Future's Past* is essentially a murder mystery with an historical twist ... and another titled *Paradise* is almost complete.

When she turned 75, voluntary work helping to raise funds for Carrick Hill through the Hidden Gardens annual event led to an 18 month part time job as publicist for the historical estate where she still volunteers on The Friends of Carrick Hill Committee.

Denese is the daughter of the late Max Redden – a former Rotarian.

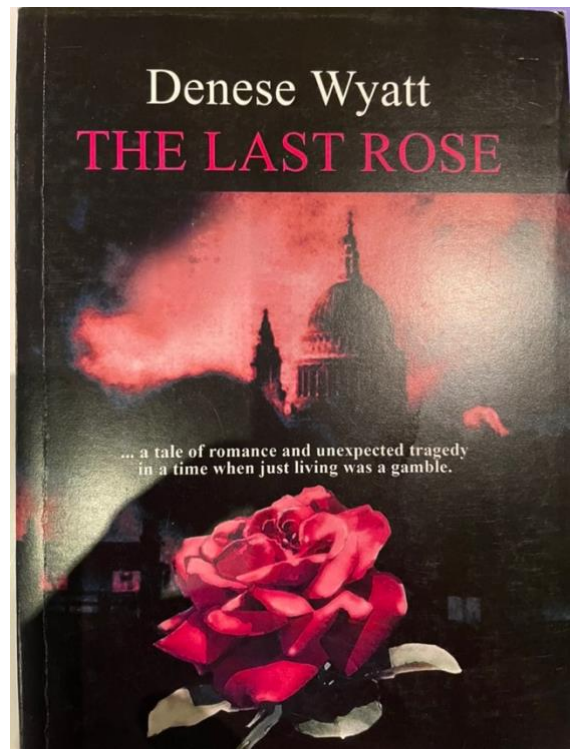
Denese has written several books including The Last Rose. Her inspirations come from family history and events.
