

Guest Speaker: PDG Marie Dorrington OAM – Interplast

Interplast is an organisation founded by the Royal Australasian College of Surgeons.

A program “repairing bodies and changing lives in the Asia Pacific region”.

Rotary has been a founding partner since 1983. Most clubs have supported Interplast.

The cost of medical treatment is the greatest barrier for many folk overseas seeking help following burns and other medical issues that affect daily lives.

Teams of qualified workers treat patients and also train locals.

An example is a plastic surgeon, Dr Sonam Jamtsho who trained in Adelaide and is now the only plastic surgeon in Bhutan.

It is estimated 5 billion people don't have access to affordable surgical and anaesthetic care when needed.




