There was much encouragement, some rejoicing when all pins fell. Gutter balls were few, particularly after the barriers were put up.


But there on this occasion was only 1 winner - 2nd year running Rod Carey took the Pennant. I did suggest a handicap for next year.


Report of Meeting 3378 held at the Art Gallery 5 August


