Did you know? Rotary in Spain

The first Rotary club in continental Europe was chartered in Madrid on January 1, 1921. Rotary's growth in Spain was interrupted during the Spanish Civil War (1936) and the subsequent Franco era.

After Franco's death and the return to democracy, Rotary clubs began to re-establish themselves.

Rotary in Spain is organized into three districts: District 2201, 2202, and 2203. There are approximately 200 Rotary clubs in Spain. These clubs comprise around 5,000 Rotarians.

The Spanish national Rotary organization (Rotary Spain) describes its mission to promote service, peace, health, education, and poverty alleviation.

Many clubs raise funds and issue grants or donations to local non-profits, social organizations, or individuals in need. For example, the Rotary Club Alcoy recently donated €1,000 to Coratge, an association helping people with acquired brain injuries.
