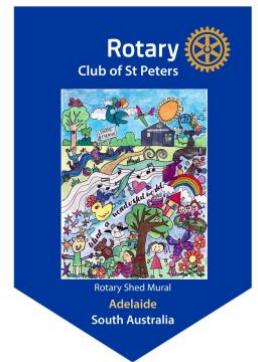

Diana then drew attention to the display stand she had set up. When she was President of the Goolwa club for two years she was inspired to do something about helping the environment. The club planted a number of trees but she became concerned about the serious situation in the world regarding plastic waste and believed Rotarians could play a part in this.

They produced a display stand and they take it to schools and the children become aware and interested in environmental issues. They ask the school children to think of ideas to save plastic waste.

They take the display to other venues and also make environmentally friendly shopping bags made of cotton to sell with 'Rotary Club of Goolwa' stenciled on them. They have also located a collapsible drinking cup that can be reused.

It was suggested during question time that these bags could be obtained, labelled with 'Rotary Club of St Peters' and sold at the shed.
