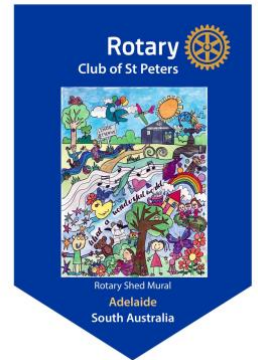

Meeting 3103 held on 17th September 2019 at the Kensington Hotel

President's Welcome - President John George welcomed Rotarians and guest speaker Judith Brown, a Past President of the Morialta club. Also welcomed were Mark and Louise Hay from the Modbury - Golden Grove club as well as secretary Pam Vaughton back from her overseas trip.

Guest Speaker – Chairman Phil Smith introduced Judith Brown. Judith is a registered nurse and midwife and has held positions in a number of nursing organisations and has worked in several overseas countries. She is a member of the Rotary Indigenous Health Student Scholarship Committee.



Judith, with a series of slides, showed how the Australian College of Midwives is working with the Rotary Clubs of Morialta and Port Moresby and the Papua New Guinea Midwifery Society to improve maternal and newborn wellbeing in Papua New Guinea (PNG) through training in leadership.

Maternal and Perinatal outcomes in PNG are amongst the worst in the world and there are currently not enough midwives in PNG.

The Maternal Mortality Ratio currently cited by the National Department of Health is 773 per 100,000 births, making it one of the highest in the world. In comparison, the rate in Australia in 2015 was 6 maternal deaths per 100,000 births.

Australian and PNG Midwives volunteer their time to participate in the program. Every participant is a member of their respective professional association. It is a new concept whereby midwife buddy pairs are formed. Buddy pairs receive training and support to build leadership capacity.
