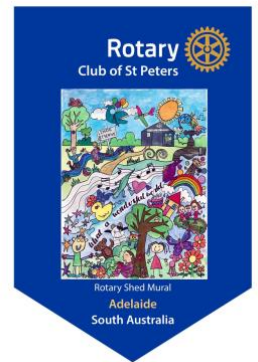

Habitat for Humanity Australia is part of Habitat for Humanity and it has helped build 170 homes in Australia.

They don't give hand-outs, rather they give people hand-ups by building homes in partnership with families in Australia and overseas. They work with vulnerable families to build new homes, which transforms people's lives. They assist each partner family to obtain a Homestart loan and the families contribute their own time in the planning and construction phases. Families partner with Habitat for Humanity in the construction of their home.

The organisation also works with communities across the Asia Pacific region to address housing poverty and Ben showed a Cambodian example of what this has achieved.
