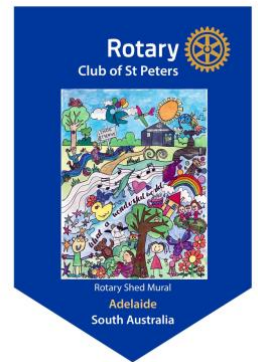

Report of Meeting 3110 held on Sunday 3rd November 2019 at Toorak Gardens - Gala Garden Party Fundraiser for AllKids in Cambodia



Chairman – Arthur Manser opened proceedings and thanked everyone for attending to support AllKids in Cambodia. He said today is about having fun and helping children in need and special thanks are due to Cathy and John Miller for their support and for providing their tennis court as a venue.

Arthur introduced John George, President of the Rotary Club of St Peters, Chairman of AllKids and the brainchild behind the Gala Garden Party.

President's Welcome - President *John George* welcomed Rotarians, Partners and the many Guests. He explained that it was a Rotary meeting which he officially opened and then immediately closed.

He said he was proud to be associated with AllKids since its inception and they have achieved some huge goals over the years. Paul Otto, the founder, together with sponsorship from the Rotary Club of St Peters, MGA Whittles and people such as those supporting and attending the Gala Party mean there are now 750 children going through the learning centre in Cambodia each week.

Seven years ago, kids were leaving school at year 4 whereas now it is year 9 and they are getting jobs, which wouldn't happen if it wasn't for AllKids.

President John and Chairman Arthur outlined the fundraising activities for the day – a wine bar where for \$25 one would take their chance of getting a valuable bottle from the ones donated.

There were quilts available for sale which were made by Cambodian mothers.

President John emphasized that all the money raised would go to the children because costs were kept to an absolute minimum by generous donations.

They also invited guests to look at photos of some children in Cambodia who would benefit from someone sponsoring them for the cost of \$30 per month. Rhonda Heilbronn explained how important it was that these children were sponsored so they could obtain an education.



An auction was held for - 7 days on the Gold Coast, a houseboat trip, jewelry, two paintings and several bottles of good quality wine. Auctioneer was Robin Turner.

Guests were waited upon by girls from St Peters College who were running a raffle because some of them are visiting Cambodia early next year.

Gala Party Report from President John – I am delighted to report that our Garden Party fundraiser was a fabulous success. Not only was it financially successful it also brought together many Rotarians and folks from all walks of life in an atmosphere of friendship.

We actually cleared \$21,800 on the day plus 11 sponsorships were taken with an annual income of \$4,560. 100% of this goes to “All Kids”

Special thanks to all who assisted in so many and various ways. From the 20 lovely young St Peters College Students to Rotarians, wives and friends who provided the fabulous array of food and flowers etc., guests were treated to a great day and learned more about the what and why we are passionate supporters of “All Kids”.
