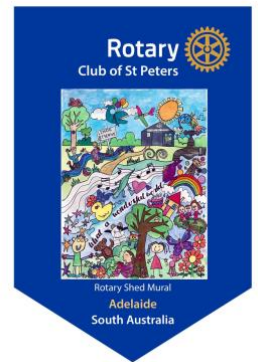

Report of Meeting 3112 held on 19th November 2019 at the Kensington Hotel

Guest Speaker - Paul Bullus - Electronic Recycling Australia

Our guest speaker this week was Paul Bullus & he was introduced by chair, Phil Smith. Paul is the Commercial Manager of Electronic Recycling Australia.



A former AFL football player (97 games with Richmond) he is married & has 3 children.

His area of expertise is logistics & sales and he is passionate about his current work with Electronic Recycling Australia.

Using a PowerPoint presentation, Paul explained how Electronic Recycling Australia offers a two-tiered approach to reusing & recycling.

Their recycling facilities have the capacity to process electrical and electronic goods from both the general public and commercial businesses. He noted that currently in Australia we are only processing 8% of our electronic waste.

Importantly the business supports Minda Incorporated by employing 40 residents from Minda Disability Support Services. Paul explained how his current work has provided great satisfaction & fulfilment for him.
