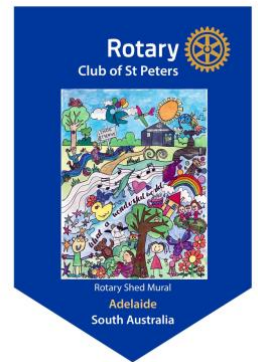

Openlight has been strengthening communities in South Australia since 1925. An initiative of Toc H South Australia Inc, Openlight was created to ensure a contemporary pathway of friendship and service that supports social inclusion, recreation and wellbeing.

For over 90 years members have delivered high-quality community programs that provide opportunities for volunteers to become active in their community, creating a lasting and positive impact on society.

With an emphasis on volunteers and members building friendship while giving back, Openlight creates an environment where service groups can focus on achieving their community goals. Openlight offers a variety of programs that inspire action and provide volunteers with real life experience while strengthening their communities.



Openlight services cover a board range of community needs including:

- **Openlight Youth Services** – a camping program at Openlight’s Victor Harbor Campsite. Run entirely by volunteers and funded by the generosity of our sponsors and supporters, each school holidays children aged from 6 – 11 years old that are experiencing disadvantage as a result of family, social or financial factors are referred by professional agencies to enjoy an opportunity to “be a kid”.
- **Openlight Jumbunna** – hold a various events throughout the year for carers of a family member with a disability or chronic illness. These include information events to help with caring roles, having some fun with family, friends and other carers, and our retreats. Male and female carers enjoy one retreat a year each, where Openlight provide an opportunity for some well-earned respite, relaxation and a chance to share experiences. This enables our members to return to their caring roles refreshed and rejuvenated.

- **Openlight Community Garden and soon to be launched Bushland Nursery**– recognises the importance of group gardening as an enabler to social connectedness and wellbeing. With a full functioning community garden at Victor Harbor, members enjoy the social belonging of the garden, while engaging in an education series of guest speakers, qualified in horticulture, environmental practices and general wellbeing.
- **Openlight Campsite** – a social enterprise business that provides important group style accommodation, catering and recreation facilities at Victor Harbor. Set on over 10 acres of natural bushland, with breathtaking views across the valley and Harbor, the campsite is available for all year round bookings.
- **Openlight “The Shift”** – the program which represents an opportunity to improve community understanding of disability and inclusion, employability skills, the enhancement of community culture and the positive self-development of participants.
