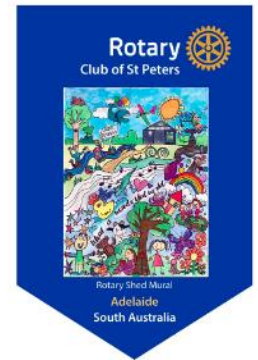

**Guest Speaker** – *Arthur Manser* introduced guest speaker Libby Bradley, a veterinarian with the Adelaide Koala & Wildlife Hospital.



The Adelaide Koala & Wildlife Hospital provides free emergency veterinary services to injured wildlife. Their main goal is to treat, rehabilitate and release native wildlife that may have become injured or orphaned from their natural environment. Most of the animals, birds and reptiles are released back into the wild, however where appropriate the group may need to arrange long term care for the wildlife.

The organisation also conducts a variety of educational programs for students, carers, veterinary students and the public.

Libby showed photos of some of the wildlife that were treated. Koalas caught in bushfires suffer burns to their paws and bums. She said it is important to only provide water in a bowl for thirsty Koalas.



They are territorial so need to be released back in their own areas and the same applies to birds such as magpies and also reptiles. One bluetongue lizard being treated for an injured tail unexpectedly produced 8 babies!

The Adelaide Koala & Wildlife Hospital is a not for profit organisation and their treatment and rehabilitation services rely solely on the generosity and support of others.

Rotarian *Rod Carey's* wife Jenny, a stalwart at the St Peters Rotary Shed, had the idea of having a special day whereby proceeds of the sales were donated to the Adelaide Koala & Wildlife Hospital.



This happened on the 7<sup>th</sup> March, so a cheque for the amount raised, \$3,230.75, was given to Libby following her presentation.

Libby presented the club with a thank you certificate.
