Report of meeting 3147 held on Tuesday 1st September at the Kensington Hotel.

Opening - Sergeant *Greg Rogers* called the meeting to order and *Keith Shaw* gave the invocation and loyal toast.

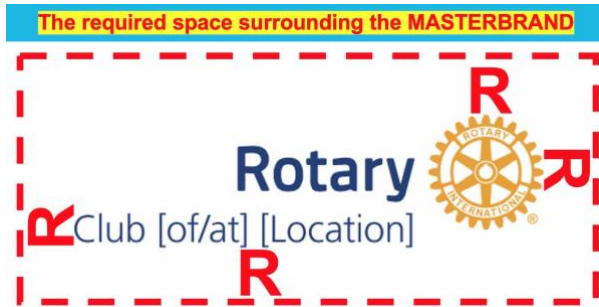

Guest Speaker – *Carmel O'Reilly* introduced guest speaker and Rotarian *Keith Payne*, who proceeded to show slides of the current Rotary International guidelines for Rotary branding. The important changes are –

- 1 All the old versions of the Rotary wheel are redundant and should not be used.
- 2 The '**Mark of Excellence**' is a new look Rotary wheel, but it should not be used alone.
- 3 The Rotary wheel should not be disfigured in any way.
- 4 The Rotary wheel combined with the word 'Rotary' on the left of the wheel is the '**Rotary Masterbrand**'.
- 5 The 'Rotary Masterbrand' should have a space separating the logo from other text or graphics surrounding it equal to the height of the letter 'R' in the word Rotary in the Masterbrand.
- 6 Rotary Districts, Clubs, Rotary Partners, Action Groups, and Programs can add their own names to the Masterbrand via the MyRotary website.

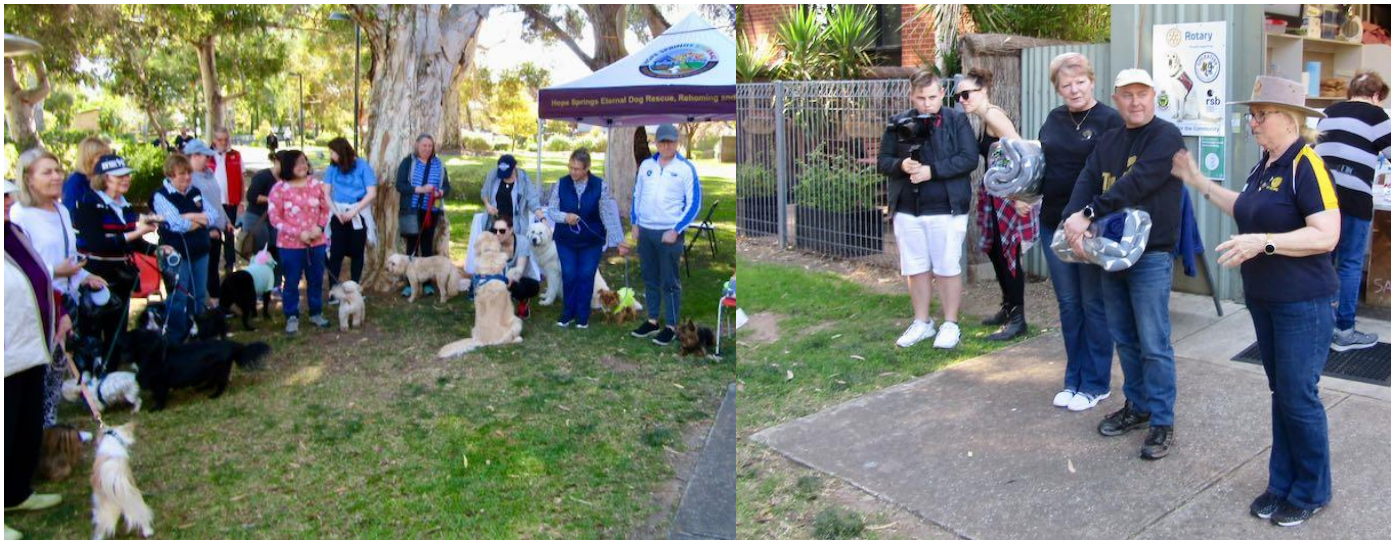
