Significance of Water & Sanitation



- Water is the most critical element for life.
- 2,200,000,000 people lack safe drinking water
- 207,000,000 spent over 30 minutes per round trip to collect clean water.
- 2,100,000,000 people have inadequate access to sanitation.
- One in 5 girls not in school because of inadequate sanitation.
