## Report of meeting 3150 held on Tuesday 22nd September at the Kensington Hotel.

### Opening

*Keith Shaw* opened the meeting and called on *Arthur Manser* to give the Invocation and Loyal Toast. President *Bill Winslow* welcomed all including guest Paul Holton.

### Guest Speaker

*Shirley Manser* introduced Greg Pattinson, who is the Chief Executive Officer of Foodbank SA and brings extensive experience gained over 30 years in a number of industry sectors. After completing a Master of Science degree at Purdue University in the USA, specialising in food science, he advanced his career in senior management roles with iconic food companies such as Inghams, Berri, Tip Top, Goodman Fielder and Maggie Beer Products, in NSW, Victoria and SA. Foodbank presented the ideal vehicle to use his experience, knowledge and contacts to help people in need, and he is enjoying every aspect of this new challenge, and especially the interaction with the corps of volunteers who help Foodbank every day.

Greg gave an extensive overview of Foodbank - Many Australians have been in a situation where they have run out of food and have been unable to buy more. Unexpected bills or housing payments are often the immediate reason an individual goes hungry. Being unable to afford enough food takes a significant toll on a person’s physical health and food insecurity can also have a devastating effect on an individual’s mental health. Women are at greater risk of food insecurity, and also feel the impacts more strongly than men.
