Guest Speaker

Club International Director *Phil Smith* introduced Nancy Geregl – Nancy is a Midwife in Papua New Guinea and a post graduate student at Flinders University. Nancy described how the buddy program between midwives in Australia and PNG operates. 86% of the PNG population live in rural parts so poor roads and communications, natural disasters and cultural beliefs mean the Maternal Mortality Ratio in PNG is 340 maternal deaths per 100,000 births.



The Australian College of Midwives is working with the Rotary Clubs of Morialta and Port Moresby and the Papua New Guinea Midwifery Society to improve maternal and newborn wellbeing in PNG through training in leadership.

Books for Lesotho



This year the International Committee is supporting Books for Lesotho by providing books for their program.

Our Rotary Shed Book Team, Arthur Terrell & John Dubberley, have been busy collecting & sorting books suitable for the students in Lesotho.

Seven boxes of books have been packed & will be delivered to the team from Books for Lesotho next week.

The Kingdom of Lesotho is an African nation with a population of 1.2m people. It is amongst the poorest nations of the world.

Its future is dependent, in part, on improving the level of education for their children, and one important facet of their education is developing their literacy. Local teachers advise that a school library enhances every part of a student's school life.

Books for Lesotho Inc. shares a vision with our two partners in Lesotho for every school in Lesotho to have a library so that students have the opportunity to develop their literacy and language skills for pleasure and learning. We also support development of libraries in institutions and communities.

Each year, Books for Lesotho sends books to its partners in Lesotho - the Transformation Resource Centre (TRC) and Rotary Club of Maloti (RCoMa). TRC distributes the books to schools and some institutions. It also monitors the ways in which schools use the books and that the books are being well used. RCoMa is more focussed on community development and so, typically, erects a suitable structure before fitting it out with shelves, tables and chairs, and then books.

Between 2007 and early 2020, some 173,000 books and reading aids have been shipped to Lesotho and distributed to some 100 schools, child/youth focussed organisations and communities.
