## The Rotary Foundation

Guest speaker was PDG *Sam Camporeale*, a member of the Rotary Club of Mitcham, who is the Regional Rotary Foundation Coordinator.

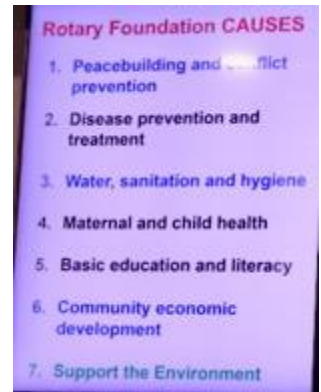
Sam commenced by contrasting our current 'crazy world' to one whereby everyone lived peacefully and treated each other with respect, regardless of religion, race or colour and people were genuinely kind to one another.

He said "Imagine if we could stop young people from dying from terrible diseases and have access to a good education so they could live a fulfilling life, free of crime and violence.

What would our world would be like if we could protect our environment, save our wildlife and for everyone to have access to clean water?"



The Rotary Foundation seeks to address some of these issues by providing funds for Rotarians to work with local populations in order to make life better for them. Sam listed the causes that the Foundation supports. These included the well-known Polio Plus project.



He showed a video which showed the local population on Manus Island telling how the construction of a special toilet block had improved their living conditions.

Sam described how funds contributed to the Foundation can multiply, to create sufficient resources to complete specific projects.

### Rotary Centurions



The second guest speaker was PDG Marie-Louise Lees from the Rotary Club of Gawler Light. Marie-Louise is the District 9510 Foundation Chair.

She encouraged those present to promote and take part in the Rotary Centurion program, whereby members contribute A\$100 annually to the Foundation.
