This Christmas Dinner was solely organised and catered for by Club members and Partners.

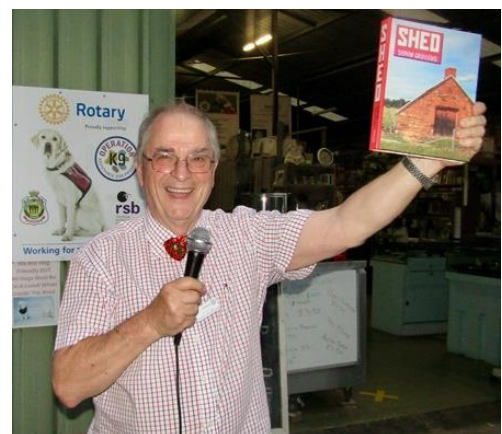
