Report of Meeting 3161 held on 19th January 2021 at the Kensington Hotel – Part 2

Opening

Sergeant Keith Shaw called on Greg Rogers to give the Loyal toast. He then asked all present to give a warm welcome to President Bill. There was a large attendance at the meeting, most Club members being present including a number of Partners.

Shirley Manser

President Bill Winslow, after welcoming everyone to the meeting, commenced by acknowledging that it was a sombre occasion, following the death of St Peters Rotarian Shirley Manser. She was originally a member of the Rotary Club of Berri and a minute's silence was then observed for Shirley followed by a toast to remember her service as a valued Rotarian.

Later in the meeting in lieu of a fines session, a collection was made in Shirley's honour. The amount donated was \$580 and the Club Board later agreed that the Club would match the amount, so \$1,160 will be donated to Australian Rotary Health. Donations can be made online at –

Phil Smith has known Shirley and Arthur for many years and he then recited poem he had written entitled 'Shirley'.

The heartfelt eulogies, especially from her family, paid a fitting tribute to the high esteem in which she was held. RIP Shirley

Guest speaker – ‘Here comes the judge’

President Bill then called on Peter Hewitt to introduce District Court Judge Steven Milstead. Peter explained that he and Steven, together with associates Kevin Beswick and Cliff Boydon, who were also present at the meeting, met together for ‘the occasional lunch’.



Steven Milstead then gave the gathering some insights into how the justice system works. He said that one element the system has to deal with is the poor public opinion about Criminal Defence lawyers.

People often wonder how a lawyer can honestly defend someone who has committed a serious crime such as child sex offences or murder. He said criticism of these lawyers was in his opinion unjustified, because they are subject to rules and laws, breaches of which carry serious consequences.

Steven also explained the difference between a lawyer, a solicitor and a barrister and went on to tell what procedures are followed when someone is charged with a criminal act and how the lawyer proceeds when a client admits to committing a crime. He said a lawyer is obliged to represent a client if asked, irrespective of media and general public opinions. In concluding he contended that over time, many innocent people may have been convicted for crimes they did not commit.

Chris Dawson thanked ‘The Judge’ for his informative talk and said that his attendance and presentation was a fitting tribute to Shirley Manser who has, for many years, recruited and organised the guest speakers for Club meetings.
