## Guest Speaker

In 2019 Adelaide Optometrist Andy Griffiths supported by partner (now wife) Kate McPhee embarked on an epic cycle around France. Here is Kate's description.....

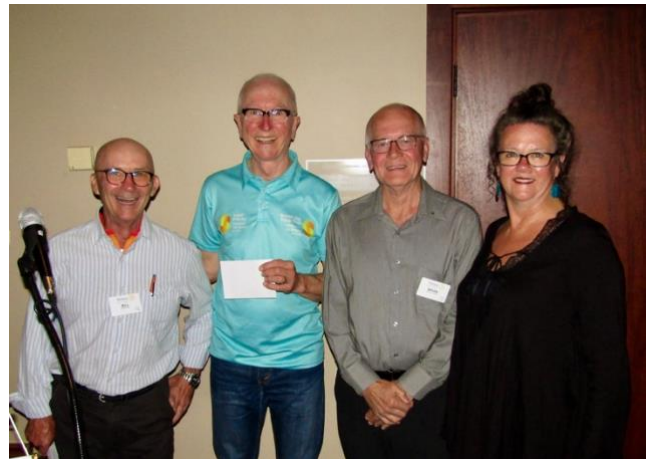


“Le Retour du Tour 1954 is an adventure we dreamt up in a moment of madness to celebrate Andy's 65th birthday. Andy spent many hours hunched over maps and computers to recreate the route of the 1954 Tour de France - the year of his birth - 4,656kms (2,893 miles) in the traditional TDF loop around France. The 41st Tour was the first TDF to start outside of France, so on Sunday 26th May we set off from the centre of Amsterdam as those hard men did. In 1954 there were 23 stages and only two rest days, but we're amateurs so we had 36 ride days and six rest days. We finished on 7th July in Paris - so - yes - that was an average of 130kms that Andy cycled each day - in torrential downpours, gale force winds, in glorious sunshine and during France's second worst ever heat wave!

Along the way, we raised funds to support the international optometry programs run by the Australian charity - Sight For All (<https://give.everydayhero.com/au/le-r...>) - 100% of the funds donated by our supporters go direct to their optometry programs in developing countries.”

Andy is a member of the local Cycling Club Bad Habit as is President Bill and Jim Eccles.

PS - Andy rode his bike to their marriage ceremony in Lobethal later that year.

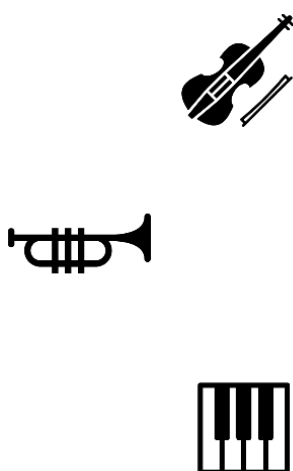

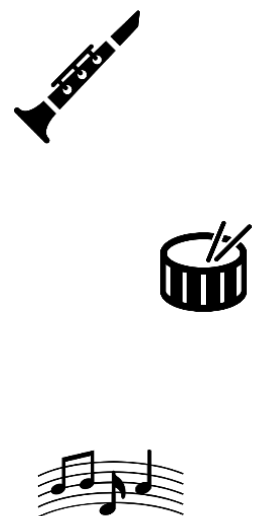
