Since completing her tertiary studies at Flinders University in 1993, Vicki has worked for not-for profit organisations that assist the aged or people with disabilities. She is leading a team of 6 who respond and support all customers enquiring about accessing Helping Hand's 9 Residential Care Homes. Vicki has two sons currently aged 20 & 16, and she very much enjoys her family life.

Tonight, we have two very experienced and qualified speakers who are making the life of aged people better. I will leave it to our guests to tell us about their lives in aged care and I understand they would welcome questions.

Vicki and Julie said Rotary had assisted Helping Hand to become established. They spoke about how the headphones donated by our Club have made a real difference to people with dementia. Each person's favorite music can be loaded on the memory card in the headphone and their faces light up when they listen to it. The main issue for administrators is the training of staff to download the music onto the memory card.

They also talked about My Aged Care, whereby elderly people can access a wide range of Government services. The preference is to keep people in their own homes as long as possible.


