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## Report of Meeting 3182 held on Tuesday 22nd June at the Kensington Hotel

**Sergeant Greg Rogers** called on **Romaine Dawson** to give the invocation and toasts.

**President Bill Winslow** welcomed Rotarians, the guest speaker Dan Edmonds and visitors from Epping, NSW, Susie and Stephen Llewelyn and Nicholle Nobel.

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## President's Remarks

**President Bill** commented on the interesting speaker last week.

He also spoke about the Dialysis Unit for Coober Pedy, supported by Purple House. Clubs across Rotary District 9510 will be aware of the Foundation project, led by the Rotary Club of Waikerie, supported by Rotary clubs across our district and with an overseas sponsor Rotary District 6040 from Kansas City. Rotary raised nearly quarter of a million dollars to equip the dialysis unit in Pukatja.

Our help is needed again. In short, Purple House have been given SA Government funds to develop a similar unit in Coober Pedy, needless to say it is not enough. Purple House need additional funds of more than \$100,000.

The unit will sit fairly and squarely in our District. It will help our Aboriginal population and as has already been proven to improve their sense of wellbeing in their own community and, it will further increase their life span.

**Guest Speaker**

**International Director Phil Smith** introduced Dan Edmonds. Dan is a member of the Rotary Club of Stirling and is the Area Coordinator – Adelaide and Environs, for Shelterbox.



Dan said Shelterbox was started in 1999 by the Rotary Club of Helston Lizard in the UK. The aim of the project is to provide the necessities of life to help families stay together following a disaster in which they have lost everything. The ‘box’ contains practical tools and utensils that help create the framework of everyday life.



The main item is a custom-made disaster relief tent to provide protection from the elements. The other items are prepared to meet the needs of a particular situation.



The ‘box’ is a gift and families can sell items after they become re-established.

The services of Rotarians and other selected agencies are used to ensure the boxes reach the intended destination.

Using volunteers means every cent raised is used effectively.

Dan commended the members of the Rotary Club of St Peters for their generous support of Shelterbox over many years.
