We heard of some kind community folk from Broken Hill; friends of our Club, who maintain wheelchairs for those needing help. It was agreed the men would cross the border and collect them next time they were down.

Well, the border was shut due to COVID 19 for the next month and many more. A year passed.... and eventually, so did restrictions.

Finally it was agreed the wheelchairs would be taken to Jack's Farm, half way to Broken Hill.... to be collected by the Broken Hill boys.

Firstly they were loaded onto the Rotary truck. Then from the truck to a member's trailer.

Then hooked onto a car. Took a break at Riverton.



The wheelchairs had a few weeks' rest in Jack's shed until the Broken Hill boys were able to slip down on a dry day for an overnight stay at Jack's Farm and be met by Jim Eccles who drove up from Adelaide.

The wheelchairs were loaded... strapped and covered, off to their new homes.
